ALASKA

12 females were murdered in Alaska in 2018

The crude murder rate for females in Alaska is 3.40 per 100,000 in 2018

Range 1 in 5 State

AGE

Females aged 18-24 were the most common age group for victims (9 cases), followed by females aged 25-34 (1 case).

RACE

Of the 12 female victims, 5 were American Indian or Alaska Native, 2 were Asian or Pacific Islander, 2 were Alaska Native, 2 were Black, and 1 was White.

MOST COMMON WEAPONS

Females were most commonly murdered with a handgun (5 cases), followed by a knife (3 cases), a firearm (2 cases), and a blunt object (2 cases).

VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

Females were most commonly murdered by an intimate partner (9 cases), followed by a family member (2 cases), and a stranger (1 case). Of the 9 intimate partner cases, 27% (3 cases) were acquaintance cases, 33% (1 case) were dating cases, and 40% (4 cases) were spouse cases.

CIRCUMSTANCE

Females were most commonly murdered in a home (9 cases), followed by a vehicle (2 cases), and a public place (1 case).

MISSOURI

73 female victims, deceased in Missouri, 2018

The crude rate of femicide in Missouri is 2.34 per 100,000 in 2018

AGE

Females aged 18-24 (72%), 4% (6%) aged 18-24, 8% (11%) aged 65 and over. Total aged 41 and over.

RACE

Of 73 African American, 42% Black, 1% Asian.

MOST COMMON WEAPONS

Females aged 18-24 (72%), 67% (44-66) aged 25-34, 73% (32%) aged 35-44, 11% aged 45-54, 5% aged 55-64, 1% aged 65 and over.

OKLAHOMA

46 female victims, 2018

The average age of the victims was 23.1, and 100,000

Range 3 in the State

AGE

Female victims aged 18 to 65. The average age was 40.

RACE

Of the 46 victims, 33 were Black, 8 were White, 2 were Asian, 1 was Hispanic, and 1 was of another race.

Firearms were the most common weapon used, accounting for 58% (23 of 40) of the cases. Other weapons included knives (18%), tools (5%), and other weapons (1%).

VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

Female victims were most commonly killed by intimate partners (97%), followed by family members (39%). Other relationships included acquaintances (71%), strangers (27%), and other relationships (63%).

CIRCUMSTANCE

Female victims were most commonly killed in the home (79%), followed by outdoors (43%), and other locations (30%).

LOUISIANA

54 female deaths in Louisiana 2018

The crude death rate for females in Louisiana is 2.26 per 100,000 in 2018

Rank 5 in the State

AGE

Female victims aged 18-64 (52%), 2% aged 65 and over. The average age of female victims is 38 years old.

RACE

Of the 54 female victims, 34 are Black, 19 are White, and 1 is of another race.

MOST COMMON WEAPONS

Firearms are the most common weapon used in 67% (34 of 51) of the cases. Other weapons include 23% (12 of 51) of cases. The most common types of firearms used are handguns (5 of 51 cases), rifles (3 of 51 cases), and shotguns (3 of 51 cases).

VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

Female victims are most commonly killed by intimate partners (100% of 50 cases). Next are family members (64% of 32 cases). Acquaintances account for 69% (22 of 32 cases), and 68% (15 of 22 cases) of the victims are killed by a single offender.

CIRCUMSTANCE

Female victims are most commonly killed in the home (83% of 38 cases). Other common circumstances include 61% (23 of 38 cases) of cases where the victim was killed in a public place.

Firearms are the most common weapon used in 68% of female deaths (42% of 62). Other weapons include knives (27%), automobiles (6%), and other weapons (5%). Tennessee's rate is 4% higher than the national average.

VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

Female deaths rate among women killed by intimate partners is 86% higher than among women killed by other relationships (55%). Non-intimate partner relationships include family members (71%), acquaintances (39%), and other relationships (76%). Tennessee's rate is 25% higher than the national average.
