## Option #1

### (Applies to continuation projects and new project applications)

1. These provisions apply to Victim of Crime Act (VOCA), Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) and State Victim Assistance Program (SVAP) grants.
2. Your proposal budget category may not exceed what was awarded in 2019. A "lowest award

amount" is the award amount that was approved by the Office of the Attorney General and

2. Equipment and certain other items will not be approved (see Option 1, #6 & #7).
3. Requests for supplies in the "Other" category will be scrutinized on a case-by-case basis and reductions may be recommended based on past usage and projected needs.
